

Indian & Chinese companies sign MoUs for contracts worth US\$ 3.43 billion

NEW DELHI, September 17, 2014. Indian and Chinese companies today signed MoUs for 24 contracts worth US\$ 3.43 billion in a range of sectors such as aircraft leasing and financing, telecom, chemicals, wind power components, , cotton yarn and fabric, synthetic fibre and seafood.

The **MoUs were signed at the conclusion of the India-China Business Meeting organized by FICCI** on the sidelines of the meetings between the visiting Chinese President, Xi Jinping and Prime Minister Narendra Modi and amongst officials from the two countries.
