BRICS Business Council mid-term meeting took place in New Delhi on March 31, 2017. The Infrastructure Working Group members discussed the plan of action for the next year as India passed on the mantle to China. Taking into account the concept of integral development, each BRICS nation selected, on behalf of the Infrastructure Working Group, priority projects to promote.

The Infrastructure Working Group thoroughly investigated existing regional physical integration initiatives involving the BRICS nations and the following projects listed by BRICS Business Council (BBC) was evaluated for mutual cooperation and Investment opportunities:

- API – Integration Priority Project Agenda, Target Region – Latin America
- The Silk Road Economic Belt
- Industrial Corridors and Smart Cities in India
- High Speed Railways
- Unified e-Navigation of BRICS Countries
- Creation of the Russian-Chinese design centre for development of advanced chipset navigation and navigation modules
