WHAT ARE TECHNICAL TEXTILES?

• Technical textiles are textile materials and products used for their functional properties and technical performance e.g. anti-bacterial patient/doctor's clothing, geotextiles for reinforcement in roads and highways, rail track bed stabilization etc.

SIGNIFICANCE OF TECHNICAL TEXTILES

- Worldwide, technical textiles is an important industry which has penetrated major areas of economic activity and infrastructure like hospitals, hygiene, defence, roads, highways, railways, agriculture, aerospace, manufacturing etc.
- Use of technical textiles is also desirable in India for a number of reasons like safety, cleaner environment, better hygiene and healthcare, sustainable infrastructure etc.
- Realizing its importance, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India announced the introduction of Technology
 Mission on Technical Textiles in 2007. Government of India has identified technical textiles as one of
 the thrust areas for growth.
- Given the benefits of technical textiles and its multi-disciplinary applications, use of these items can improve the quality of life significantly.

POTENTIAL FOR TECHNICAL TEXTILES IN INDIA

- In India, technical textiles is emerging as an important industry which has high growth potential both in domestic market and exports.
- Technical textiles industry in India can achieve a compound annual growth rate of 11% and market size of Rs.70,151 crore by 2012-13.
- Given the rising disposable incomes in India, the use of these items is bound to increase in coming years.



FOCUS AREAS: MEDITECH & GEOTECH

- Meditech and Geotech are two important segments of technical textiles. Meditech includes textile materials used in hygiene, health care and personal care as well as surgical applications. Some of the examples of Meditech items are baby diapers, incontinence diapers, sanitary napkins, surgical sutures, artificial implants, surgical dressing materials, patient's/surgeon's uniforms, face masks, caps etc. According to the baseline survey of Ministry of Textiles, Meditech industry in India is projected to achieve an yearly growth of 9% and the market size of the sector is likely to increase to Rs 2,263 crore by 2013 from the current level of Rs 1,669 crore.
- Geotech includes products used in Geotechnical applications pertaining to soil, rock, earth etc. like
 geogrids, geonets, geomembranes, geocomposites etc. Geotextiles are of utmost importance for civil
 engineering projects like roads and pavements reinforcement, slope stabilization, rail track bed
 stabilization, ground stabilization; for marine engineering projects like soil erosion control,
 embankment protection, breakwaters and for environmental engineering projects like landfills and
 waste management etc. According to the baseline survey of Ministry of Textiles, Geotech industry in
 India is projected to achieve a significant growth and is expected to double its market size by 2012-13.
- For both Meditech and Geotech, there are number of institutional buyers/consumers in India like Government hospitals, National Rural Health Mission, NHAI, Border Roads Organization, Airports (Runways), Defence & Railways hospitals etc. Besides, demand for meditech products is likely to increase manifold with retail consumers also.

CONTEXT OF CONFERENCE

• As the market grows, it is important that not only new investment comes in but also the existing investments are scaled-up in terms of size, technology, standards etc. Technical textiles, including Meditech and Geotech, provide lucrative option for existing players in the textiles industry to diversify their portfolio and hedge their risks associated with just one segment. Currently, India is dependent on imports for some of the important items of Geotech and Meditech. Subject to certain changes in regulations and specifications, the investment in Geotech and Meditech is going to unleash in the country. In this context, Ministry of Textiles & FICCI are jointly organizing NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON "STIMULATING INVESTMENTS IN TECHNICAL TEXTILES: MEDITECH & GEOTECH" with an aim to encourage investments in Meditech and Geotech.
