

H.E. Mrs. Kátia Abreu, Minister of Agriculture, Livestock and Food Supply

H.E. Mrs. Kátia Abreu is the Brazilian Minister of Agriculture, Livestock and Food Supply.

Her political career began when she assumed the presidency of the Federation of Agriculture and Livestock of the State of Tocantins.

One of the most dynamic ministers in the government of President Dilam Roussef, Kátia Abreu had been chosen to lead the agricultural caucus in Brazilian Parliament, becoming the first woman in the country to do so.

In 2008, she was the first woman to occupy the presidency of the Confederation of Agriculture and Livestock of Brazil (CNA), a position to which she was elected for the third time last year.

An entrepreneur, Kátia Abreu also owns business in agro-food sector and in India at the invitation of the Indian government leading a 42 member business delegation.

Brazil is an agricultural superpower and a major producer, consumer and exporter of a wide range of agricultural products. Collaoboration with Brazil would be essential in ensure the Food Security of India as Brazil offers opportunity to India to not only export our products but offer opportunities in commercial farming, food processing, cold chain technologies and energy/biomass (ethanol).
