

## Report on **"FICCI's Empowerment & Enrichment Program For Teachers"** 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> April 2016 (Monday & Tuesday), ISTE Professional Centre, Chennai

FICCI – Tamil Nadu State Council organized a two days training program titled **"FICCI's Empowerment & Enrichment Program for Teachers"** which was held on 18th & 19th April 2016 in Chennai. Teachers from 34 different schools from in and around Tamil Nadu participated in this first such training program organized by FICCI TNSC. The session were divided into Primary Teachers and Secondary teachers and restricted to only 50 per batch.

Viswanathan, Convener, Education Panel, FICCI TNSC & Former Vice Chancellor of Anna University** while delivering the welcome address said schools to adopt and implement the emergent approaches to improve student learning include Modern Methodology in teaching, Functional and Development Skills. He also said schools to provide regular training for teachers in developing teaching skills.

But the truth of the statement can never be debated. The impact a teacher makes on the lives of a learner is so significant that it shapes the learners' thoughts, perceptions, life styles, thinking and activities. However, from the perception of a teacher as the fountain-head of all knowledge from where the wisdom flows has undergone a



tremendous change and in the instant knowledge society, where there is mind-boggling flow and dynamics of knowledge, the teacher is required to be competent, contextual and relevant. Teacher needs to have a more focused professional approach to deliver the defined, required curricular competencies to a challenging classroom. The teacher is required to be more than an information broker but a guide, facilitator, mentor, counselor and motivator.

Mr P Murari IAS (Retd.), Adviser to FICCI President & Former Secretary to President of India while delivering his inaugural address said the most common role of teacher plays in the classroom is to teach knowledge to children. The school curriculum is followed by the teacher so that throughout the year, all pertinent knowledge is dispensed to the students.
