<u>About Textiles in Healthcare</u>

Healthcare Textiles are used as Medical Textiles for direct patient care as well as Non-Medical Textiles mainly for normal human usages or for office/patient accommodation spaces.

Purpose of hospital textiles

Healthcare textiles are used to improve quality of health care delivery by minimizing the risk of infections & providing comfort to patients who are bedridden for 24 hours.

Broad Categories of Hospital Textiles

(I) INDIRECT TEXTILES:

- Office Linen: incl. Office Linen e.g. Curtains, Furniture/furnishing Linen
- 2. Housekeeping Linen: Wipes & Dusters
- 3. Linen for Support Services:
 - Drapes & gowns for Kitchen
 - ii. Wrappers for CSSD-Sterile Supplies
- 4. **Bed Linen:** This is of two types:
 - Linen for admitted patients: Bed Sheets, Pillow Covers, Blankets
 - ii. Linen for Attendants

(II) DIRECT PATIENT CARE TEXTILES: For Hygiene Purpose

This is of following types:

- 1. Linen for Patient use: Hygiene Textiles
 - Patient uniforms in General Wards
 - Patient uniform in Intensive Care Units/Operation Theatres/Procedure Rooms
- 2. **Surgeon' uniform** in OTs/ICUs: Surgeon's Operating Dresses & Gowns
- 3. OT drapes/Surgical Table Linen/Surgical Sheets

(III) PATIENT PROCEDURE TEXTILES: For Treatment Purpose

1. Organ Procedure Materials

- Surgical Sutures
- Surgical Implants: e.g. Grafts, Mesh for Hernia,
- Non-implant materials e,g, dressings, plaster pads
- 2. Extra corporeal devices: e.g. Artificial kidney

(IV) PROFESSIONAL UNIFORMS LINEN (Liveries)

Professionals Uniform (Liveries) which include Staff Uniforms & Dresses

Recent Advances in Hospital Textiles

Anti-Microbial Fabrics

- Antimicrobial fabric is a textile that has been treated to help inhibit or destroy the growth of disease-causing microbes.
- □ Common compounds used are:
 - Quaternary Ammonium compounds: targets the microbial membrane.
 - Triclosan
 - 'Smartsilver/Livinguard Technology": Nano particles (Silver) coated/TiO2 coated 'infection free'/stain free fabric

Usage of KHADI in Hospitals

- Recently hospitals started using Khadi fabric items.
- Hospital Khadi products which are approved by the Ministry include bed sheets, abdomen sheets, dressing towels, surgeon gown, surgical patient gown, kurta pajama, doctor's coat.
- Khadi being the most natural and organic skin friendly fabric
- □ High user satisfaction.

Shift to Disposable Fabrics

> Allows air and moisture to pass through

Allows Economic aspect vary from product to product (surgeon's dress to patient sheets)

CHALLENGES AND ISSUES of HOSPITAL USERS

Linen Selection at Hospital

Linen is provided in most of hospitals as per the technical specifications provided by the Linen Selection Committee.

However very few hospitals in India are having standards and specifications for medical linen.

Hospital Linen Policy

- No Standard Protocols except in few hospitals. Poor selection & poorly changed linen enhances the treatment cost.
- Many hospitals change linen everyday, some not. Recently Introduction of Colour Bedsheets on all seven days in a week started in Central Government Hospitals to ensure hygiene.

Quality Challenges

- Indigenous R& D required for medical textiles in order to bring down the treatment cost.
- Scientific study required with regard to appropriate application of various Medical Textile products.
- Lack of customized production & design in India specially for patients needs to be looked for.
- Union Ministry of Textiles identified BIS/SITRA standards should be used by all hospitals for selection of hospital textiles.

Washing Challenges

Hospital textile is different from normal textile.

- Washing done at high temperature (60-80degree
 Celsius) with drying at 80-130 degree Celsius
- Purpose: To make fabrics infection free. However it leads to decresed life of fabric!

Linen Washing Standards for Hospitals

 Hospital Laundry needs to have standards for washing in India just like Hospital Laundry Accreditation Council (HLAC) standards in West.

 Different washing procedures destroy the very basic purpose of hospital fabrics: Infection free healing.

Washing detergent & formula standards

 Standards similar A.I.S.E. Guidelines on the implementation of the Detergents Regulation required for India.

 Ingredient Datasheet for Medical Personnel provided in these standards.

Holistic Hospital Textiles

 Attention on Hospital Textiles in Holistic Manner: A Recent Phenomenon

 Medical Textiles are part of Healing Process: Equally important as Medicine for control of infections & disease
