**15%** increase in production from 2015-16.

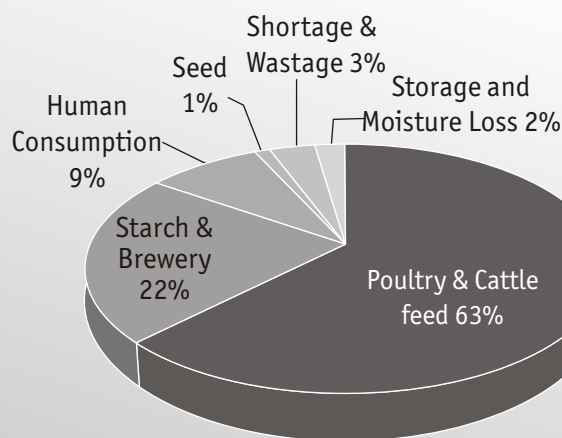
**10%** increase in area from 2015-16.

**10%** share in total food grain production.

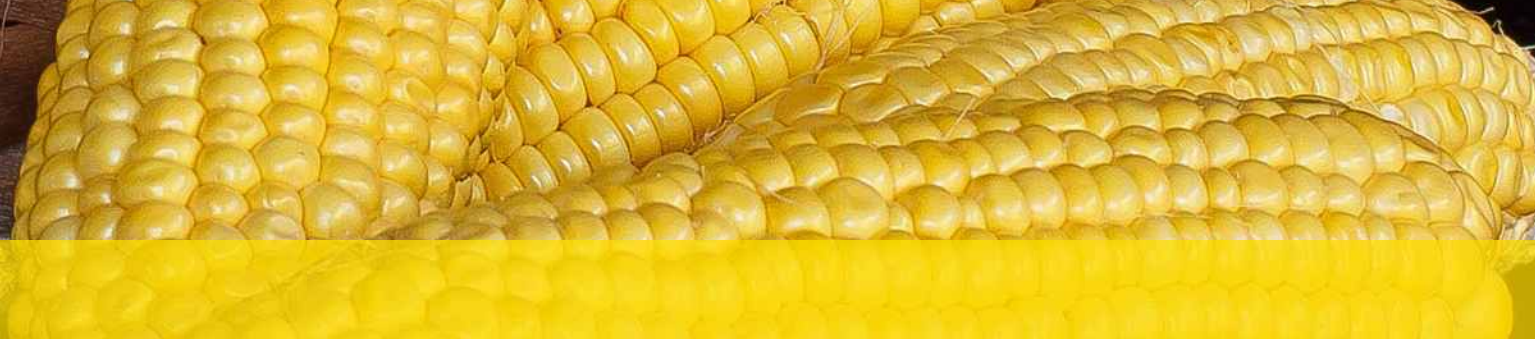
**7%** consumption growth rate over last 5 Years.
