





## Regional Conference on "Safety Management in Industries, Hazardous Waste Management, Storage & Transportation of Chemicals, Petroleum, Petroleum Products and Capacity Building of North Eastern States towards Emergency Response"

National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), Government of India, Directorate General Factory Advice Service & Labour Institutes (DGFASLI), Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India, Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce & Industry (FICCI) and Government of Assam have joined hands in organising a Regional Conference on Safety Management in Industries, HWM, Storage & Transportation of Chemicals, Petroleum, Petroleum Products & Capacity Building of North Eastern States towards Emergency Response on October 8-9, 2018 at Guwahati.

**National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), Government of India** was constituted in Sept, 2005 consequent to enactment of Disaster Management Act, 2005. Hon'ble Prime Minister of India is ex-officio Chairman of NDMA. NDMA, as per its inter alia mandate, has brought out National Guidelines on (i) Chemical (Industrial) Disaster Management (CIDM) (ii) Medical Preparedness & Mass Casualty Management (iii) Incident Response System (IV) Scaling, Type of Equipment and Training of Fire Services; the objective of the guidelines is to strengthen prevention, mitigation and preparedness measures; minimize accidents; and set up an effective mechanism to respond to disasters.

**Directorate General Factory Advice Service & Labour Institutes (DGFASLI), Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India** is an attached office of the Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India and serves as a technical arm to assist the Ministry in formulating national

policies on occupational safety and health in factories and docks. It also advises factories on various problems concerning safety, health, efficiency and well-being of the persons at work places.

**Chief Inspector of Factories, Government of Assam** - The functions of this Inspectorate involve multifarious activities contemplating the safety, health and welfare of the workers. This Inspectorate enforces labour legislations in the registered factories and protects the interest of the workers employed therein by effective implementation of safety and Health standards.

### **Pollution Control Board, Assam**

Pollution Control Board, Department of Environment & Forests, Government of Assam is an autonomous statutory organization constituted on with a view to protecting the environment, preventing and controlling the pollution of water and air in the State of Assam, occupying a prominent niche in progressive and industrial development of the country.

**Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce & Industry (FICCI)**, an apex industry association, has organized several training & education programmes in all major industrial sectors in coordination with accredited Indian and global agencies.
